

Science Classroom Expectations QUIZ for Extra Credit

Fill in the blanks.

1. What is the first thing (#1) on the board every day that you are supposed to do?
Write in your planner
2. What is the second thing (#2) on the board every day that you are supposed to do? **Bell Work**
3. You are asked to bring a science spiral, science folder, pencil bag with several pencils, dry erase marker, and highlighter, AR book and planner to class every day.
4. (Who) **Anyone** in the class may correct and turn in a homework assignment within 2 days of it being handed back and Mrs. Venn will use the highest grade out of the two assignments.
5. Students who earned less than a "B or 80%" have a **stamp** on their paper that says "Please Correct." These students must correct the work and turn it back in within **2** days of it being handed back for a better grade. (Mrs. Venn doesn't chase the people down for their corrections; it is up to them to turn it in.)
6. (Who) **Anyone** in the class may accurately correct their quiz or test and retake it for a better grade.
7. Parents can tell if their child corrected any papers/quizzes/tests and turned it in for a better grade by seeing the **redo** comment on Parent Portal next to the assignment. This means it WAS corrected and turned in within the two day period.
8. Students can get a pass from Mrs. Venn and stay after school for **VELO** if they are struggling with a concept we are working on in class.

True or False Questions (Pull down either True or False)

9. Your Bell Work must be completed **exactly** the way Mrs. Venn asks you to do it. She tells us how to do it both out loud AND it is typed on the board in case we forget. **TRUE**
 10. If you do **NOT** follow **all** of the directions given for the bell work, you still get some credit for doing it. **False** Instead, you get **zero** credit for the assignment in the science spiral.
 11. Science spirals are collected once or twice throughout the unit and are worth 20% of your total grade. The spirals have your daily bell work and notes in them. **TRUE** (See question 10 for details about the spirals.)
