Make sure that your questions go in a certain order that makes sense and it is very clear what you are asking of the person.

**Goal of this task:** After your presentation, you want the audience to reflect on what they have just learned. Here are some possible reflection ideas:

- Before the presentation, what was your understanding about light bulbs?
- Which type of light bulb is currently used the most in your house right now?
- What were some surprising facts that you learned?
- What type of light bulb do you think is best for the environment and why? Cheapest in the long run?
- Do you have any more questions for me?
- Is there anything that the presentation should have expanded on more?
- Is there anything that the presentation spent too much time on?

You can make it a sentence completion where the person finishes the sentence with their answer, a rating scale, a checklist, or a combination of these types of questions.
